

EcoCIPP LINING CASE HISTORY



Sewer Rehabilitation From Perco

A failing egg shaped brick sewer in Leeds City Centre gave us a great chance to show just how flexible our Cured in Place GRP Lining system, EcoCIPP, really is!

The affected sewer was close to the Debenhams store in Briggate Street in a busy pedestrianised shopping area.

Main contractor, Earthtec Morrison chose the EcoCIPP system for:

- Speed of installation
- Quietness compared to hot water cure systems
- Reduced environmental impact

A 56 metre length of the 1080 x 720mm sewer had to be relined at night to minimise noise and disruption to local businesses and pedestrians.

Working out of hours on a Tuesday night (to avoid weekend revellers) we were allowed access to the site by 7pm and had to be finished by 6am.

Within the tight timetable, the sewer was cleaned out and all of the lateral connections were plotted using CCTV. The sewer was relined and then the lateral connections reopened, using Perco's new lateral cutting system to

establish flows through the pipe.

The job went without incident apart from occasional interruptions by a few alcohol infused young ladies wanting to chat up the work team!
