## Sewer Rehabilitation From Perco

Gaymer's Cider Company operates its production facilities to the highest standards of hygiene control, and when its Shepton Mallett factory's drains and sewers needed rehabilitating, Perco was able to offer a clean, non intrusive solution to the problem.

Following a site survey, Perco recommended rehabilitation using EcoCIPP, Perco's exclusive UV cured in place liner system. EcoCIPP offers all the advantages of conventional 'wet' CIPP systems but can be installed in

half the time whilst avoiding the need for installation towers, water heating systems or need to dispose of contaminated waste water afterwards.

12 separate lengths of 225mm ID pipes running under the factory needed to be upgraded.

Using EcoCIPP meant that we could work from existing man holes and launch pits dug outside the factory. The installed liner had a wall thickness of only 4.2mm yet offering a stronger section than conventional liners

because of its unique design and construction. EcoCIPP is also resistant to aggressive waste materials and industrial cleaning solutions

To minimise disruption to factory operations, the works were carried out at night and at weekends
